1. Presentation and discussion on the findings of the first phase of the 2014 update to the City's Integrated Water Master Plan (IWMP) - NO ACTION

Public Works Manager, Terry Lowe and Public Works Director, Dick McKinley gave an overview regarding the City's Integrated Water Master Plan (IWMP). A powerpoint presentation was reviewed.

Mr. McKinley stated that it represents the total indoor.

Council Member Biundo asked how many acre feet we use per year right now.

We average 7,600 per year.

Council Member Williams spoke of HOA dues, water supply and cost.

Council Member Villanueva asked if Surprise would be able to handle water for the OTS.

Mr. Lowe stated that if El Mirage ever had water issues we could send water their way.

Yazmin Padilla inquired about groundwater and Yuma's use of water.

Mayor Wolcott asked that the water Sub-Committee bring back a report to the Council for consideration.

Public Comments:

Ken Wright - Surprise does not have complete control of the Colorado water basin. The upper part of the Colorado is using approx. half of its allocation, and the other half is flowing to lower basin. Denver currently has a requested for some of the water. 100 year water supply is a big joke, needs to be taken to the state legislature. Several lawsuits in Arizona on the use of water.
