MINUTES OF THE MEETING

C. CURRENT EVENTS AND REPORTS

Commissioner Van de Langeryt had nothing to report.

Commissioner Hertzog reported following up with a few homebuilders about accessibility to mailboxes and provided information to them. He recommends observing mailboxes to make sure they are compliant and take appropriate steps to provide information to homebuilders when needed.

Commissioner Renou had nothing to report.

Vice Chair Stutzman reported the following:

Surprise Youth Council has a Haunted maze scheduled for 10/28 & 10/29 at the Sierra Montana Rec Center and Bubble Soccer on 12/10 at the Eight Acre Park on Bullard. These events are open and available for disabled youth. Zenia the Current DAC/Surprise Youth Council Liaison has since left the Youth Council. The name of Connor Williams as a possible replacement Liaison was recommended. Contact with Paul Bernardo in order to confirm the new Youth Council/DAC Liaison is in process.

Beth Medley of the Maricopa County Library System in Surprise was contacted to attempt to restart the Shake Rattle & Read Program. They are currently too busy but may reconsider in the Fall.

As mentioned previously, anyone who has concerns with non-compliant mailboxes in their community is encouraged to email the DAC. Commissioner Hertzog is recommended as the point of contact.

Consideration of nominations for the Community of Sun City Grand for the Above & Beyond award and for the DAC to decide on one or separate nominations for the individual departments. Additional detailed information outlining their community enhancements toward accessibility will be provided for discussion when presented as an agenda item.

Commissioner Van Natter reported Special Olympics Swimming Practice Tuesdays (Hollyhock) & Fridays (Surprise) from 6pm to 8pm. Swim Meets Friday and Saturday the 2nd weekend of October. Information will also be posted by the City of Surprise.

One Step Beyond has extended their program by offering a new class for those needing reduced stimuli.

Background:

Sun City Grand Community Association

1. Over 50 mechanized auto door openers - started with exterior doors, then restrooms, followed by locker rooms, and most recently to every private club building
2. Golf Department has a special golf cart for persons with a disability called a Solo Rider
3. Braille department signs
4. Club for the hearing impaired
5. Special moveable seating for professional and local shows in the entertainment venue allowing for persons with a disability or in a wheelchair to have wider choice of seating and ability to attend with groups (sit with their friends - not the "handicapped" section)
6. ALL walking trails in the community are FULLY handicapped accessible. Every mile (30? or so) of trails is completely paved to ADA standards with no steps, curbs, or steep inclines. In addition, the trail system features a state of the art 911 system with GPS markers every 600 feet that in case of emergency you just alert emergency services of your exact location for rescue assistance on trails.

Sun City Grand Fitness Department

1. Pool lifts at both Fitness centers
2. Graduated slope walk-in entrances with railings at each pool (zero-entry)
3. Special non slip tile at the request of a resident with a disability
 - a. in the locker room
 - b. in the pool - which required the pool to be drained to install (existing tile was "non-slip" already ADA compliant)
4. Lecture series by Fitness or medical professionals for those with a disability or illness
5. Special fitness classes for those with special needs
 - a. Rusty Hinges - for joint disorders
 - b. PWR! Moves - for those with Parkinson's and Dystonia
6. Water wheelchair
