1. Discussion pertaining to an update on the City's Public Art Program.

Julie Akerly, came to present this item. She talked about the Community Input Priorities: namely Parks, Community Centers and Libraries, Projects for Local Artists, Easily Accessible, City Center, and Neighborhoods. She further talked about Locations Plans, Project Phases, Fabrication of FY24 Traffic Cabinets, Fabrication of MCRC Construction Fencing, Fabrication of Bounce and Swing. She also talked about the Design for Confluencia, Oasis Court Mural; Artist Selection for iHOLA, FY25 Traffic Cabinets, Community Center Wall, and Park & Gym Wall. Julie also talked about the FY26 Proposed Projects, Collection Restoration, Public Art Sketching Tours, and Creative Economy Support.

Councilmember Judd, asked the maintenance costs and if its taken into account for new artwork? Julie said their consultants consider things that require less maintenance. He asked the projected maintenance costs? Julie said it would help to determine what is needed over time. He then asked about the traffic cabinets? Julie said they were vinyl wrapped. He asked how long they last? Julie said they would replace them with new artists as they wear out. She said they would evaluate them and that Goodyear has them last about 5 years. He asked about the basketball court and how durable it would be? Julie said she's working with consultant to consider the paint used. He asked the lifespan on the court and the mural? Julie said the court should be 10 years and the mural possibly longer.

Councilmember Hastings, asked about neighborhood lending libraries? He asked which art piece is the one in need of immediate repair? Julie said she would be evaluating those right now, she said there's a mural at Benivda in the community garden.

Councilmember Cline, said that many HOA's don't allow lending libraries.

Mayor Hall talked about how excited he was for the stadium item.

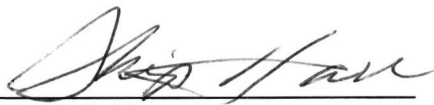
